Jesus makes the wonderful impression upon people in this weekend's gospel. He speaks with authority. One may link this word with the word authenticity. Jesus is authentic in everything he says and everything he does. That authenticity, that authority flows from his nearness to the Father. Jesus is 'plugged in' to the Father and his love so that it really is the Father's love that Jesus proclaims in all he says and does. It's an authority, and authenticity, a closeness that our world longs for and can find in us.

On Thursday 2nd of February we will celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord; a feast rooted in everyday life. This Feast is also called Candlemass, for it is an illumination, a revelation of Christ as the fulfilment of God's promise. On Thursday, as we gather before Mass we will bless these candles which symbolise Christ as the light of the world and will walk in procession with our candles lit. The 3rd February is the feast day of St Blaise, the patron saint of throat illnesses. On this day in many places people gather in churches for the blessing of throats.

This week we will continue to celebrate the true light that came into the world. Christ is the light against darkness, the light which no darkness in our lives can overcome. Christ is present in our everyday lives sharing his victory with us.
