As Fr Clement is preparing to leave Bexhill on the 5th of July, I take this opportunity on behalf of the parish to say a huge and sincere THANK YOU for his service and support. His support has been invaluable whilst we have been without a parish priest. We wish him well in his future priestly ministry. We will keep you in our prayers.

There is the old saying; "there are no atheists in fox holes." When we find ourselves in desperate and seemingly hopeless situations even the non-believer discovers God and cries out to Him for help. While we probably would not describe ourselves as a non-believer, we do have the tendency of trying to solve our own problems first. When all our efforts and plans fail, in desperation we cry out to God. This is especially true when it comes to someone being diagnosed with a serious illness. We include this petition in our usual daily prayers, search for the cure that the medical professionals tell us does not exist, when these seem to fail we storm heaven with prayers of pleading as we hang onto hope for a miracle. Miraculous healings do occur and people do testify to that from experience. There are times when the unexpected, inexplicable change for the better takes place. When these happen there is great rejoicing and prayers of thanksgiving. There are times when the healing doesn't take place and we wonder where God is, and ask, "Why is this happening?" The Gospel from Mark (5: 21 - 43) gives us accounts of healings.

Healing is a complex issue because we don't know the mind of God. Why some people are healed and others are not is a mystery that calls on a deep faith to accept. Sometimes we are attracted to various forms or methods of healing, but the power of Jesus cannot be confined, channelled or controlled by these. His healing is a gift to us that seems to come when we open our hearts and invite him into these situations. We are called to have the faith to invite Jesus into our lives, and allow his will to be done.
