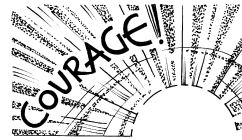

ADOREUMS: Eucharistic Congress in Liverpool

As the Church in England & Wales gathers for the Eucharistic Congress, we too, in our celebration of Holy Mass, consider more deeply our 'Eucharist' or 'thanksgiving' for Christ's sacrifice. Our Lord says: 'Do this in memory of me'. The word "remember" is crucial to our understanding. When we remember we pause, reflect and learn lessons, but when we "remember" in the Eucharist we go deeper. When the Jewish People remembered the Passover, they believed they were being drawn once again into God's saving action. A member is "one who participates" and so to "re-member" means to "participate again".

Our Lord says, 'where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them' (Mt18:20). And so when we 'remember' what Christ has done, we are drawn into God's saving action as the cross of Christ is "re-presented" before our very eyes where He pours out his blood for the forgiveness of our sins, opening up for us the way from death into life. Our Lord, the Good Shepherd, comes to seek out the lost sheep, but at his passion and death, the people, including those closest, abandoned him.

In the Holy Mass we're given another chance to take station with him at the foot of the cross. This drives our Eucharistic attitude as we 'give thanks' for all our blessings while uniting our sufferings to Christ's sacrifice. To assist us in our pilgrimage he gives us our viaticum (*our food for our journey*) to help us get home to heaven. As we've been considering this summer in our reading of John Chapter 6 we understand Holy Communion to be the 'bread of angels', being nothing less than the **body, blood, soul and divinity** of Christ Jesus our Lord and God. Strengthened by the Eucharist we're able to carry our own cross to Calvary and 'pass-over' with him from death into life.
