World Youth Day / Flame 3

This Sunday Pope Francis celebrates Mass for World Youth Day in Panama City. There is no formal group from Arundel & Brighton this time, as our previous bishop decided only to attend only when in Europe, out of a concern for the group's safety and our carbon footprint; and this time it takes place during term time! Nonetheless, World Youth Day is perhaps the largest festival in the world, making gatherings such as Glastonbury seem like a village fayre.

In his homily for the opening Mass on Tuesday Monsignor Jose Domingo Ulloa Mendieta, Archbishop of Panama said: *'in these days of WYD, the pilgrims will have the opportunity to be in catechesis with bishops from different countries, to have interesting instruction; to enter the Park of Forgiveness, with places for confession; to reconcile with God; to enter the Youth festival in which the variety of talent from different countries offers possibilities to nourish the spirit; and to enjoy the special encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist, our spiritual food for facing the challenges of life. This meeting of you young people with Jesus Christ should lead you to confrontation with yourselves and with the indoctrination of the anti-values system that prevails in the search for a false happiness, which is so fleeting that it leads you to reach desperately for so many things that damage the mind and spirit and that ultimately fail to fill the existential vacuum. Youth: this call is still real, lasting, intense, and full of a tenderness that only Christ knows how to communicate.'*

While we may have to wait for a European World Youth Day, know that on 2nd March 2019 "FLAME", the National Catholic Youth Event returns to Wembley Arena. 10,000 young people (ideal for school years 9/10 upwards) from England and Wales gather for inspirational talks, praise music and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Miss Doyle at St Richard's is co-ordinating the school and parish group. If you would like to go, please see her and obtain a letter.
