"The anointing of the sick, by which the Church commends the faithful who are dangerously ill to the suffering and glorified Lord in order that he relieve and save them, is conferred by anointing them with oil and pronouncing the words presided in the liturgical books" (Canon 998). The Church encourages those who are to be anointed to have the opportunity to make a confession before hand and so the priests will be available from 2pm. The communal celebration of the sacrament of the sick, for those who are properly prepared and disposed, can be performed according to the prescripts of the diocesan bishop. And so,

Who is this Mass for? The celebration of the Holy Mass is for the whole community who gather in solidarity with the sick and housebound of the parish, for whom the priest especially offers the sacrifice of the Mass. Individuals should think, who in their family, would benefit from being present at the sacrifice of this special Mass (*especially our elderly relatives who otherwise find it hard to come to Mass on Sunday*).

Who may be anointed with the sacrament of the sick? This sacrament may be administered to a member of the faithful who having reached the age of reason, *begins to be in some danger of death due to old age, or by way of significant illness, or because of injury or is a person in need of an operation under general anaesthetic*. The sacrament can be repeated if the person, having recovered, again becomes ill or the condition worsens. In the case of the frail and elderly, it is appropriate to receive the sacrament again since last year's Mass as by definition another birthday has brought them a step further on their pilgrimage.

For those not in immediate danger, but also in need of some form of healing may benefit as follows: The priests of the parish will be available to hear Confessions from 2pm, this sacrament being one of the ordinary sacraments of healing. The individual should unite their suffering to the sacrifice of Calvary in the sacrifice of the Mass at 2.30pm and then by receiving, in a state of grace, the Most Holy Eucharist in Holy Communion, both explicitly sublime occasions of healing. At the end of Mass, following the pattern established by the A&B pilgrimage, the clergy will be available to pray and bless those struggling with any kind of tribulation, such as bereavement and anxiety etc.

After Mass the SVP team provide afternoon tea in the hall!
