

**The Church of St Martha's, Little Common**  
**Planning a Resumption of the Sacred Liturgy**  
**An Update: 19<sup>th</sup> July 2020.**

On Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> July, a team of volunteers donned masks and gloves and gave the Church a deep clean, making it COVID-secure but in a way that it still feels like St Martha's. The Church, therefore, is ready to welcome people to Mass but with social distancing it only has a capacity of 36 people. As people from the same household may sit together that capacity might be slightly increased at the judgement and discretion of the stewards.

**What do we need to do next?** We now need parishioners to volunteer as stewards. We are looking to add the following Masses to our schedule to complement and not compete with what has been established at St Mary Magdalene. Therefore, we are looking for teams for:

1. 9am on Sundays
2. 6pm on Saturdays
3. 9.45am on either and / or Monday and Thursday mornings.

Stewards should be:

- Under 70 years of age, (essential)
- Free from underlying health conditions (essential)<sup>1</sup>
- Hold a current DBS (desirable)
