Holy Communion Reminders

- Distributed after Mass.
- Stewards will direct you.
- Do not come forward until directed. The stewards will bring a handful of people forward at a time to keep the flow round the one-way system.
- In the Hand only – speak to the priest at the end of Mass if you have a real problem with this.
- “*The body of Christ / Amen*” is said collectively. Individually, we receive in silence.

Face Coverings: Unless you are exempt, face coverings should be worn while attending places of worship, including Churches (*removed carefully for Holy Communion*).

Public Masses in our parishes have been celebrated again since 12th July (*see page 4 for the list of public Masses*), and so far there have been no capacity issues with about 15% of our pre-COVID congregation ready to return to public worship of God, being in his presence and ministering to him. At present, ***the most important ministry from the people of God is stewarding***, to ensure that congregations are welcomed safely into the Church in line with social distancing. We are grateful to the nine teams of stewards who are facilitating this, but we must be mindful of them, not over-burdening them or taking them for granted. ***Without them we will have to return to Masses celebrated online only.*** They are acting on my behalf, so please follow their instructions with due care.

Please discern: **God is calling you to offer yourself as a steward** so that the people of God in our parish can continue to stand at the foot of the cross and give thanks for the sacrifice that takes our sins away and have access to heaven. If you are a parishioner, are under 70 and have no underlying health conditions please email: stmm@btconnect.com so that we can add you to one of the existing stewarding teams.

As Elijah discovered, God was in the sound of a gentle breeze: While all Masses are being celebrated in their simplest form at the moment, there has been one notable blessing and that is the **silence before Mass which is letting God speak**. As always, we speak to God before Mass, he speaks to us during the liturgy and then after Mass we speak to others of our joy of encountering the Lord in the Sacred Liturgy, telling them that Jesus truly is the Son of God as we share his gospel with them.

[**Public Mass Times are reviewed weekly, are dependent on stewards being available, and like the Railways, the timetable is subject to short notice cancellations and amendments*] Requiem Masses continue to have priority.
