Your love, O Lord, is eternal: discard not the work of your hands

Who do you say that I am?

Jesus asks this same question of each one of us. He is Jesus of Nazareth and He is the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity, one person with two natures, one fully human and one fully divine. He is, as we pray in the Creed, 'God from God, light from light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father'. Being consubstantial means that he shares the same essence of God. Whatever "it is" that makes God, God, Jesus shares it with the same glory and majesty. This means he is not just a prophet or a quirky rabbi but God Incarnate, Emmanuel (God-with-us); meaning his gospel is not a philosophical work but the words of eternal life and his teaching is an extension of the commandments of God! At Holy Baptism, we are asked: "Do you believe in Jesus Christ, [God's] only Son, our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, was crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father?"

"I do", we declare; then Blessed are you indeed!
