Parish Halls Update

Having reviewed the Risk assessments for the re-opening of parish halls, we have concluded that the cleaning requirements are currently too prohibitive to their reopening. They will remain closed for the foreseeable future. Bishop Richard said to the clergy, '...such a re-opening will require a good number of measures to be in place and the decision to open a hall should not be taken lightly'. This has a financial impact on the parish, so we appeal to your generosity in your offertory giving. We are working through the Risk Assessment to enable the St Mary Magdalene Presbytery to re-open for limited socially distant parish usage, in time for the resumption of Sacramental programs in the autumn but depends on resolving boundary issues.

Bishop Richard has encouraged the clergy to take some holiday, and Fr Rajesh and I have held off as long as possible to help facilitate the re-starting of Public Masses over the summer and to honour all the Mass intentions which you have requested for the repose of the soul or good estate of your loved ones. I will be away from 2nd to 19th Sept. and Fr Rajesh will take some time in October, and so we have set the Mass Rota according. While I am away there will no Live stream Mass from the Parish but there are plenty of other sources.

We have been blessed in our stewards over the summer who have facilitated safe entry to our Churches and cleaned them after each Mass. This requirement looks likely to be with us for some time, and so we ask parishioners who are under 70 and have no underlying health conditions to join a stewarding team. We have checked with our stewards their availability for September. As to October... it is too early to say. Please contact the parish office if you can help as a steward.

As more parishioners become comfortable in returning the Mass, <u>so far</u>, we have been blessed in not having to turn people away. Also, we have not needed to put a booking system in place. Therefore, Public Masses remain on a first come-first served basis and we reiterate the advice of the bishops' conference that the obligation to hear Mass on a Sunday remains suspended and if you have already been to Mass during the week we ask you to be mindful of others, perhaps not taking a seat away from someone else. Finally, I wish all pupils and staff a safe return to school this week and wish you every blessing for your continued formation.
