For our annual Parish and Diocesan statistics, we kindly ask our stewards to count all parishioners and record on the document provided. The counts take place on the last two weekends of September and the first two weekends of October. Thank you.

Places of Worship remain open in line with our current precautions and restrictions we already have in place:

- The obligation to hear Mass on a Sunday remains suspended.
- If you have symptoms, please do not enter and book a COVID test.
- Face coverings should be worn over mouth & nose, unless you have a medical exemption.
- Please sanitize your hands on entry and exit.
- Please follow the instructions of the stewards.
- Please sit apart from one another if you are not part of the same household or bubble
  - Couples or households of up to 6 people may sit together.
- Capacities:
  - St Mary Magdalene 55+ units of people.
  - St Martha's 36+ units of people.
  - [Be mindful of others, if you can come on a weekday perhaps save a space at the weekend for someone else].
- Please try and give your weekly offertory online.
- The parish halls remain closed.
- The Parish Office remains closed to personal callers.
- Please volunteer as a steward if you are able.

**First Holy Communion Masses:** to be celebrated on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> November, at 12noon at St Martha's in Little Common. Thank you to those who have agreed to act as stewards. ***Families may contact the parish office with your preferred FHC Mass date (max 10 children per Mass). Each family bubble may not exceed 6 people.***

**Confirmation Masses:** ***12 noon on Sat 10<sup>th</sup> October & Sat 17<sup>th</sup> Oct. at St Martha's in Little Common.*** A reminder that these are ticket only events. There are no tickets on the door.

**St Richard's Catholic College, Supplementary Forms:** ***There is one further opportunity to have your supplementary form signed by Fr Simon: 7pm on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October.*** It is on a first come-first served basis, with a socially distanced queue.

**Supplementary Forms for St Mary Magdalene Primary School:** Parents are required to sign the declaration that they have, "YES or "NO" attended Sunday Mass at least once a month for at least one year prior to the closing date for applications" (16 January 2020 to 15 January 2021). This has not been possible from April 2020 due to Covid-19, because the church was closed between 20<sup>th</sup> March and 4<sup>th</sup> July. Although public worship has resumed, due to the government limitations on public gatherings and the need for some to continue shielding, the Sunday obligation to attend Mass remains suspended. Fr Simon is still required to countersign the Mass attendance declaration, and you are now declaring that you have "YES" or "NO" attended Mass at least one month prior to April 2020. Fr Simon will sign forms at St Mary Magdalene Presbytery at **9am on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> November and again at 9am on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> December.** It will be on a first come-first served basis and there will be a socially distanced queue. You should begin to look for your baptism certificates now as there is a charge of £10 to replace them via [stmm@btconnect.com](mailto:stmm@btconnect.com) in advance of the signing dates.
