

Government Mandated Suspension of Communal Acts of Worship.

Despite a good number of MPs speaking favorably in Wednesday's debate on behalf of Places of Worship, the regulations proved to be unamendable and so a Lockdown is now in place. Fr Simon and Fr Rajesh will celebrate Mass during this period. Fr Rajesh will celebrate privately in the presbytery and Fr Simon will say Mass in the Church privately but will Live Stream on the Parish Facebook Page:

First Holy Communion Masses: all 4 Masses are now postponed. New dates will be announced after the lockdown period ends.

Supplementary Forms for St Mary Magdalene Primary School: Parents are required to sign the declaration that they have, "YES or "NO" attended Sunday Mass at least once a month for at least one year prior to the closing date for applications" (16 January 2020 to 15 January 2021). This has not been possible from April 2020 due to Covid-19, because the church was closed between 20th March and 4th July. Although public worship has resumed, due to the government limitations on public gatherings and the need for some to continue shielding, the Sunday obligation to attend Mass remains suspended. Fr Simon is still required to countersign the Mass attendance declaration, and you are now declaring that you have "YES" or "NO" attended Mass at least one month prior to April 2020.

NEW SIGNING DATES: Due to the lockdown the 9am session on Sat 28th November is **cancelled**.

Fr Simon will sign forms at St Mary Magdalene Presbytery at **9am on Saturday 5th December and at 9am on Saturday 12th December**. It will be on a first come-first served basis and there will be a socially distanced queue. You should begin to look for your baptism certificates now, as there is a charge of £10 to replace them via stmm@btconnect.com in advance of the signing dates.

New deadline to receive applications: 13th November. First session: now begins on 22nd November. The Bishops have clarified that the 'rule of 6' does not apply to sacramental programs as these are educational but the course will most likely employ a significant online element.
