Christmas Collection in support of the Clergy

In the offertory collection at Easter and Christmas, you are invited to support the income of the priests, *who do not receive a salary from the parish or diocese* but rely on the offerings you give throughout the year in Mass offerings and stole fees. The Christmas collection makes up 25% of their annual income and so your generosity is much appreciated. As places at Mass remain limited at the moment, with the authority of the diocese, **the offertory collection for Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and the Octave Masses (25 Dec-1Jan) will be for the clergy.** Single use and COVID-secure green envelopes will be available at all Christmas Masses. If you currently have an online standing order or direct debit *this is your parish offertory* and cannot be transferred over to the Christmas collection. Please either utilize the green envelope and physical collection when you come to Mass at Christmas or throughout the octave, or make a separate BACs transfer with an explicit reference of "Christmas" so the administrators know you intend it to be paid to the priests. The Sacrament of Confirmation: we have been told that the bishop will not administer Confirmations in 2021 until the autumn rather than in early summer which is customary. We had our 1st session on 22nd November but with only 4 Confirmation (25% of normal numbers). Therefore, we have pushed back the next session until January which also allows for more young people to join the programme.
