HOLY WEEK, TRIDUUM & EASTER SUNDAY

Having read the guidance, we are able to offer the following schedule for Holy Week.

**Bookings are Required for
Palm Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good
Friday, Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday
(Bookings open: Tuesday 9th March)**

Palm Sunday: Facebook Only Masses at 9am & 6pm. Public Masses: 11am & 6pm at St Mary Magdalene only.

Holy Thursday: 8pm Public Mass of the Lord's Supper (+Facebook) in St Mary Magdalene Church.

Good Friday:

- 1) 3pm Commemoration of the Lord's Passion in St Mary Magdalene Church (+Facebook).
- 2) 6pm Commemoration of the Lord's Passion in St Martha's Church.

Easter Vigil in the Holy Night:

9pm Vigil and 1st Mass of Easter in St Mary Magdalene Church (+Facebook).

Easter Sunday Public Masses:

- 1) 9am at St Martha's (+ Facebook)
- 2) 11am at St Mary Magdalene.
- 3) 6pm at St Mary Magdalene.

Capacities remain at: St Mary Mags. 47+ people and St Martha's 36+ people. Shorter versions of liturgical options are preferred, and some elements of the rites are omitted or deferred until later in Easter or at Pentecost.

National Day of Reflection (Prayer) for COVID 19

Tuesday 23rd March 2021

The Prime Minister has asked for a National Day of Reflection to ponder the anniversary of the first national lockdown. The Bishops Conference has issued a statement welcoming the day, but rightly reframing this day so that it becomes for us a day of prayer. You can read the statement here:

So that you may pray in the Church as well as throughout your working day both St Mary Magdalene and St Martha's Church will be open for private prayer before the Blessed Sacrament either before the Tabernacle or in Exposition:

Tuesday 23rd March 2021

- 11am to 12noon at St Mary Magdalene,
- 6pm to 7pm at St Mary Magdalene,
- 6pm to 7pm at St Martha's,

All the usual COVID security remains in place, so many thanks to the stewards who have agreed to facilitate this.

Passiontide

This weekend begins the Passiontide part of Lent, when we would usually cover the various holy images, the statues and crucifixes waiting for the revealing of the reality of the Cross on Good Friday. While COVID means we cannot go up ladders to cover the images, perhaps, at home you could veil some of your statues, crucifixes, and images ready to unveil them on Good Friday. NB: Lockdown Rules remain in force so if you need a lift to Mass, this can only be provided by a member of your own household or support bubble. This advice will still be valid for Holy Week & Easter Sunday.

Church Capacities: 36+ people at St Martha's Church and **47+** people at St Mary Magdalene Church. Due to some damage to the windows in STMM Church, some further benches have been roped off.

Easter Collection in Support of the Clergy

In the Easter Collection, we invite you to support the income of the priests, who do not receive a salary but rely on your offerings throughout the year. The Easter collection makes up 25% of their annual income and so your generosity is appreciated. At the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday Masses, single use and COVID-secure green envelopes will be available, and the offertory box can be found by the exit door. As places at Mass remain limited and many remain cautious, you can also give online. If you currently have an online standing order or direct debit this is your parish offertory and cannot be transferred over to the Easter collection, so please make a separate BACs transfer with an explicit reference of "Easter".

Holy Week in the Syro-Malabar Rite: St Thomas More, Mission

We have agreed with Fr Jose that there may be Holy Week Liturgies at St Martha's in the 'Syro-Malabar Rite' as follows: Palm Sunday 28th March: 3pm, Holy Monday-Wednesday: 4:30pm, Maundy Thursday: 3pm, Good Friday: 12pm-2pm, Holy Saturday 3rd April: 7pm, Easter Sunday: 11:30am. All COVID assurances on capacity, stewarding, social distancing, and cleanliness have been given. All booking enquires should be made direct to the Syro-Malabar team and not to the Parish Office.

First Holy Communion

2020 Pending Celebrations: Having reviewed the Roadmap for Unlocking, celebrations of First Holy Communion will be no earlier than 17th May, and to allow for a proper celebration we have provisionally allocated 12noon on Saturdays 26th June and 3rd July at St Martha's to complete the 2020 celebrations.

Bookings will open after Easter (after 12th April), as stewards and musicians will need to be arranged first and we need to be sure that the government roadmap is still on schedule.

2021 Preparation: Thank you to those who have applied for the 2021 preparation. You should now be working through your 'I Belong' book. After completing the 1st four chapters, **and no earlier than 17th May**, you may begin to make an appointment with Fr Simon or Fr Rajesh to discuss your progress and make your **First Confession**. Dates for 2021 Holy Communion celebrations will not be released before 17th May.

Baptism applications can still be submitted: www.stmmbexhill.co.uk/baptismal-form/ and you will then be directed to the online preparation. Due to current restrictions, celebrations cannot happen before 17th May.
