### Note from Bishop Richard

All of us are conscious that we may not be too far off the further lifting of restrictions and the way in which all our parish communities have responded to the limitations of this last year and more has been wonderful. I much hope that it will be possible to share good news before too long and assure you that further updates will be sent out as quickly as possible. In the meantime, let us continue to implement the following precautions: *Hymn books and Mass books continue not to be in use, Holy Communion is distributed under one kind only, the physical exchange of the Sign of Peace remains suspended, the offertory basket continues to be positioned where parishioners can make their offering on arriving at or leaving church, doors and windows should be opened to provide ventilation, the church should be cleaned after services and Hand sanitising should be available to those entering or leaving.*

#### Ordination to the Sacred Priesthood

This Sunday at 3pm in Arundel Cathedral, Bishop Richard will ordain Deacon Stephen O'Brien to the Order of Sacred Priesthood for service in our Diocese of Arundel & Brighton. Please pray for him, his family, and his parish of St Mary Star of the Sea in Hastings. Fr Simon will be in attendance.

On **Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> July**, we will celebrate three anniversaries of Sacred Priesthood:

- 1) Fr Simon and Fr Rajesh will travel to Ashtead to join with Provost Anthony Churchill as he celebrates his Golden Jubilee, 50 years of Sacred Priesthood. This obviously means that there will be **no public Mass at 10am in St Mary Magdalene on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> July**.
- 2) Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> July is also Fr Simon's own anniversary of priesthood (8 years) and he will celebrate a **public Mass** in St Mary Magdalene Church at 6pm. *There are no stewards on duty. It is, therefore, expected that if you choose to come you will complete 'track and trace' using the NHS App (or sheet) and then clean your own seat afterwards.*
- 3) We also send our prayers and best wishes to Fr Paul Gilliam who also has 10<sup>th</sup> July as his Ordination anniversary having been ordained in St Mary Magdalene in 2015.

**Church Capacities: 50 units of people** (up to a max of 66 individuals) at St Martha's and **60 units of people** (*max 80 individuals*) at St Mary Magdalene. See note below "Government Roadmap".

### **Parish Halls (reminder)**

**St Martha's Hall:** The opening of St Martha's Hall will be reviewed **no earlier than 19<sup>th</sup> July** and will depend entirely on what social distancing and sanitization is required by the Diocesan Insurers. At present, the hall must be cleaned and sanitized after every booking and done in a COVID-secure manner. We are not permitted to leave this to the hall hirer. This means it is not practical or economical to re-open this hall until the lifting of restrictions. It will also depend on the pastoral needs of the parish.

**St Mary Magdalene Hall:** This is closed for extensive and complicated repairs following an underground flood discovered just before Easter. There is no date for completion of these repairs, as we are being guided by the Insurance's Loss Adjustor. Therefore, we have no estimate on when it might re-open.

**The Presbytery:** The administrators are present to deal with your email and telephone traffic. The office is not open to casual callers. The Pastoral Centre in the Presbytery is only open to pre-booked appointments that relate to the administration of the sacraments and not to other pastoral activity. Once the Quinquennial (**booked for 26-30<sup>th</sup> July**) for the whole parish estate, we will have a better understanding of the maintenance needs of the parish and any temporary adjustments to the use of our buildings while repair work is being carried out. This will require your on-going financial support and understanding.

Congratulations to the 14 children who receive their 1<sup>st</sup> Communion this weekend.

**Confirmation:** Confirmation Mass at 7pm in St Mary Magdalene on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> October 2021. We are very fortunate to have our own parish celebration. This Sunday's session (4<sup>th</sup> July) is a film, and our head catechist has sent an email to the '*Confirmandi*' explaining how to access it. The next session after that will be **in-person** session at 4pm in St Martha's Church on 18<sup>th</sup> July and will be focussed on prayer.
