### **Celebration of Mass for our Patronal Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (3-8<sup>th</sup> October)**

These are the opportunities for parishioners to be at Holy Mass for the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary:

**Rosary Sunday (2/3<sup>rd</sup> October):** Vigil Mass at 6pm (STMM), 9am (St Martha's), 11am & 6pm (STMM).

**On the Feast Day (7<sup>th</sup> October):** Mass at 6.30pm in St Mary Magdalene (with Fr Simon).

**Pontifical Mass (8<sup>th</sup> October):** Mass at 7pm in St Mary Magdalene (with Bishop Richard Moth).

*(This Mass on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> October includes our 5 parish Confirmations and replaces the 10am Mass).*

### **The Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary (7<sup>th</sup> October 2021)**

The Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary commemorates the extraordinary victory of European Christians at the Battle of Lepanto in 1571 over the Ottomans. On paper, Europe should not have won, being vastly outnumbered in ships and men. The victory was attributed to a Rosary procession through the streets of Rome on the eve of the battle. As we pray the Rosary this October (the month of Our Lady), we will process through the mysteries of the Gospel, the good news of our own salvation from sin and death.

**Parish Halls (updated):** to open St Martha's Hall needs a volunteer team of cleaners to ensure that all the main touch points in the hall are cleaned each day it is open. After speaking with the diocese, we are hopeful that some movement on this guidance will be received soon. At St Mary Magdalene, the new Hall floor will be laid in October. Unfortunately, the damp damage in the kitchen has been declared as 'historic' and will not be covered by the insurance claim, and so this will need to be repaired before it can reopen.
