

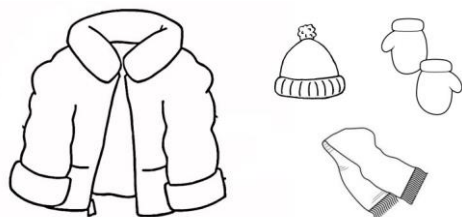

Requiem Mass for those Fallen in War

11am in St Mary Magdalene

We gather in the Church for 11am for the Last Post and Silent Reflection. Mass will then be celebrated for those fallen in war. After Mass, we lay our wreaths at the 'Peace Memorial', before moving to the 'Memorial Garden' to bless the Ashes Plots of those buried there. At other Sunday Masses (33rd OT B) there will be an opportunity for remembrance: *'They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old: Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn. At the going down of the sun and in the morning, we will remember them'*. Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them, may they rest in peace. Amen. Parish Pastoral Support Team

Fr Simon is grateful to a group of parishioners from across the Parish of Our Lady of the Rosary, with a wide range of experience in the parish, who have approached him and offered themselves as a pastoral support team. They will meet on 1st Sunday of Advent to begin forming their remit to help revitalize the pastoral life of the parish and to help Fr Simon form our pastoral direction moving forward. We will introduce them to you soon after the first meeting but many of them will be well known to you. CONFIRMATION: Applications for Confirmation 2022 are now **open**, and close on Friday 19th November. Application forms can be found here: <https://stmbexhill.co.uk/confirmation/> The first session will be at 4pm in the Presbytery on Sunday 21st November 2021. **If you live outside of the geographical boundaries of the Bexhill Parish** (e.g. St Leonard's, Hastings, Eastbourne and Battle) we may send you to your parish priest for his permission for you to join our Bexhill course. If you are part of the 'St Thomas More' Syro Malabar Mission, we may send you to the S.M. Chaplain for his permission to join the course.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: following the completion of the 2020 & 2021 First Holy Communions, we are taking the usual period of review, reflection, and discernment about moving forward. This means we will not be starting the 2022 First Communion Programme just yet. **Applications will open on 1st Sun. of Advent (28th Nov. 2021).** This will allow families time to return to Mass before beginning their preparation.

Parish Office: the office is open in-person only to those with pre-booked appointments, otherwise the administrators can assist you by email or telephone (Mon-Fri, 9.15am to 4.45pm). **Pastoral Facilities:** any parish group wishing to use St Martha's Hall should contact the Parish Office (*before restarting*) to complete their individual risk assessment. St Mary Magdalene Hall remains closed.
